### Background

Taungurung Clans Aboriginal Corporation (TCAC) has requested Right People for Country Program (RPfC) support for the Taungurung Family Engagement Project. The project will engage with Taungurung people in family meetings to gain a rounded understanding of community aspirations not only for TCAC, but for Taungurung people as whole.

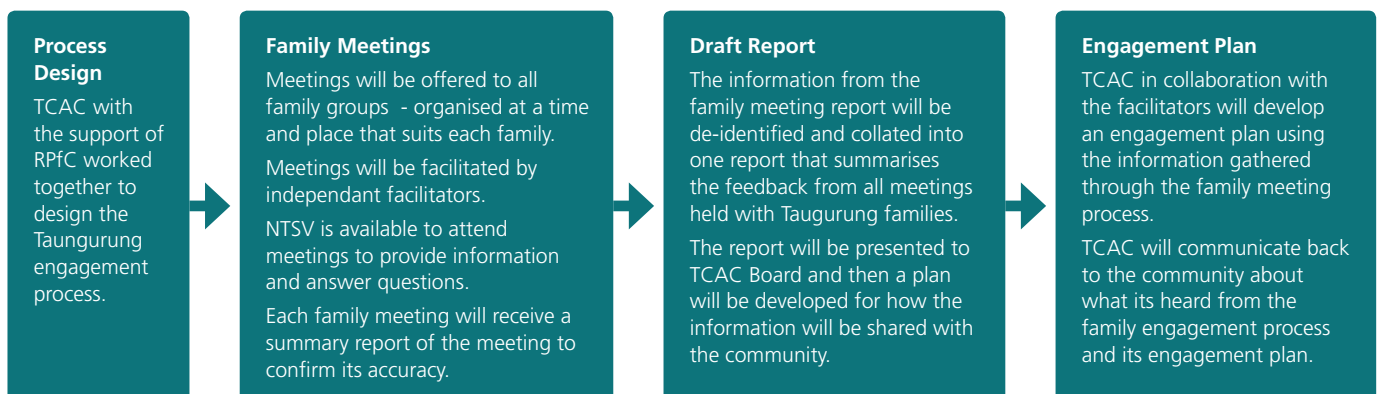
### Purpose

The purpose of the project is to hear what's important to you as a Taungurung person and family through a series of family meetings - to hear your aspirations, concerns, priorities and questions for TCAC. From your feedback the project will support TCAC to develop strategies to strengthen engagement with Taungurung people.

The family meetings will also allow time to:

- Get your help in developing new Taungurung Decision Making Guides
- Share information about the proposed Taungurung settlement agreement under the Traditional Owner Settlement Act

RPfC will coordinate the Family Engagement Project and provide independent facilitators and meeting support. RPfC's involvement ensures that the engagement process is independent and that information shared in the family meetings is confidential to each family with feedback de-identified and collated before being provided back to TCAC.
